
Band parents to sell Dewey's cookies, buns for Christmas



In Wednesday's Flower Show Linda won the "Award of Merit" the top award for Dahlias. She received a ribbon for a creative centerpiece design titled "Going to the Garden." And competing with all collections in Fridays Flower Show she won the top award "The Collector's Showcase."

Additional top winners included Garden Club President Carol Quinn with 49 ribbons, Donna DuToit – 29 ribbons, Karen Coley 25 ribbons, Bonnie Rockaway - 17 ribbons and Judy Culler - 11 ribbons. Other noted awards included a ribbon for Ann Cornwell's design titled "Going Nuts" and Judy Culler for her crossstitch piece; top ribbons awarded in antiques went to Helen Boon for her glass butter dish, silver table serving piece and family quilt; Donna Dutoit - early turn of the century buttoned shoe and family photography equiptment; Shelby Nichols - emboidered linens; and Diane Burke - medical instruments.

The Bermuda Run Garden Club meets monthly but planning successions are ongoing throught the year. They have a vision, broad in scope, covering the whole spectrum in which their club plays a county role in supporting programs like Lunch Buddies, Special Needs Children Thanksgiving outreach, Pearls of Empowerment, Hospice, Storehouse for Jesus to name a few.


